As a member of the Division's Technology team, the Computer Technician will perform and maintain a high level of understanding of all computer hardware and software that is used in the Division and will diagnose, evaluate, repair and or resolve computer hardware and software problems.

- Evaluate, diagnose, maintain and repair computer hardware, software and components
- Install new or used computer equipment
- Install and maintain software
- Maintain a journal record of expenditures
- Perform, monitor and maintain an inventory of technology equipment and parts for the Division
- Develop, implement and maintain a regular maintenance schedule for school and office computer hardware and software
- In a timely manner, report significant or recurring problems with computer hardware or software
- Provide staff workload management and daily supervision of casual or summer student employees
- Monitor parts inventory and maintain an adequate supply of computer component parts for repair purposes
- Maintain a positive relationship with computer hardware and parts suppliers
- Monitor and maintain Internet connections in the division
- Provide recommendations on budget and changes that will better enhance the technology within the division
- Develop and maintain the School Division and School Web pages as required
- Other job-related duties as required
