ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE EEAAB – STUDENT TRANSPORTATION FOR PROGRAM NOT OFFERED

Programs Not Offered in Rolling River School Division

In lieu of school bus transportation, a student who is resident in the Rolling River School Division and who is approved to enroll and attend school in another School Division because he/she is enrolled in a program of study that is not offered in the Rolling River School Division, may be paid a mileage allowance equivalent to the annual transportation grant paid by Manitoba Education.

The allowance will be pro-rated to a monthly fee to be paid on a monthly basis subject to the following conditions:

- the student continues to reside in the Rolling River School Division,
- the program is a public-school program recognized by Manitoba Education and is not offered in the Rolling River School Division,
- the student attends over 50% of the recognized program courses each month, and
- the student does not receive school bus service from the receiving Division.

A student will not be eligible for this allowance if he/she takes up permanent residence out of the Division at any time during the school year.

Programs Not Offered in a Student's Catchment School

In lieu of school bus transportation, a student who is resident in the Rolling River School Division and who is approved to enroll and attend school in another catchment area within the Rolling River School Division, because he/she is enrolled in a program of study that is not offered in his/her resident catchment area, may be paid a mileage allowance. This daily allowance will be equivalent to the projected cost of vehicle fuel per day from the student's primary residence to the closest school bus route stop for the out-of-catchment area school to be attended.

The allowance will be calculated based on 50% of the Professional Development mileage rate (reference Policy DLC Employee Travel/Expense Reimbursement) for the total round-trip kilometers from the student's residence to the closet school bus route stop for the out of catchment area school to be attended.

The allowance will be paid on a monthly basis subject to the following conditions:

- the student continues to reside in the Rolling River School Division
- the program of study that the student is attending is not offered in his/her resident catchment area school and
- the student attends over 50% of the recognized program courses each month based on actual number of days attended per month.

The Division Administration staff will administer the approval and payment of transportation allowances for students attending a Program Not Offered in the Division or within a catchment area of the Division according to the following procedures:

- The Secretary-Treasurer, prior to consideration of a request for a transportation allowance, must receive a completed School of Choice form indicating the acceptance of a student to a Program Not Offered in the Division or resident catchment area school.
- 2. A Program Not Offered refers to a complete program of study recognized by Manitoba Education with defined graduation requirements set by Manitoba Education.
- 3. The Division will notify a student/parent(s) of eligibility to apply for a transportation allowance following confirmation from the receiving Division or school that the student is enrolled and attending the applicable program of study.
- 4. In the case of a program attended outside of the Rolling River School Division, the receiving Division must also confirm that the receiving Division is not transporting the student. An eligible student / parent(s) will be required to confirm in writing that the student meets the eligibility criteria. (refer to Appendix attached).
