ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

JFCB – PROPERTY DAMAGE

Parents of minor age students or students 18 years or over will be charged for property damage costs as follows:

- Students who willfully damage school property - charged up to 100% of the cost of repair or replacement.
- Students who accidentally damage school property – charged up to 50% of the cost of repair or replacement.

Students may be required to do community service to work off assessed damage to school property.

Damage to technology devices and equipment supplied to student(s) by the Division will be governed by this policy.

If a device requires repair or needs replacement, the Information Technology Supervisor will assess the device without any cost to the student or parent.

- If the student is at fault, the repair cost will be paid by the student or parent.
- If it is determined that the student was not at fault, the device will be repaired or replaced and up to 50% of the repair cost may be charged to the student or parent.
- The amortized price of the device will be charged to the student for any device that is lost or stolen. (except for a student in their graduating year).
