ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE

EEAAA – STUDENT TRANSPORTATION – WINTER DRESS

Student safety is the primary concern in the transportation of students.

Students transported by school bus are expected to dress appropriately for the weather conditions and the potential hazards that could develop in the event of mechanical failure or other emergencies.

- The Bus Driver will report concerns regarding appropriate student dress for the weather to the School Principal and Transportation Supervisor.
- The School Principal and Transportation Supervisor will discuss the concern and decide on appropriate action to take.
- Students will not be denied access to school bus transportation due to inappropriate dress until the School Principal and/or Transportation Supervisor has discussed the concern with the student's parents or legal guardian.
- If a student is denied access to the school bus transportation due to inappropriate dress, a letter so stating will be provided to the student and their parent(s) by the School Principal.
